Overview

The candidate who is selected for the WAPPA Country Representative Award 2020, will be announced at the WAPPA Awards and Grants sundowner on Friday 6 November 2020.

Key Information

Purpose

The WAPPA Country Representative award is for an individual who has made high level contributions to WAPPA and WAPPA members as well as for education in Western Australia in a regional context. The Country Representative Award is open to any WAPPA member who has made significant voluntary contribution for WAPPA in country region or remote location.

WAPPA Country Representative Award recipient will receive

- **Certificate.** Framed certificate of acknowledgement.
- **APPA Conference.** Complimentary registration, travel & accommodation to attend the APPA conference in the following year.
- **Awards & Grants Presentation Night.** Free attendance for the recipient and a guest.

Eligibility

- The Country Representative Award is open to WAPPA Ordinary Members.
 - Who have rendered valuable service or significant contribution to WAPPA and/or WAPPA members in a country region or remote context.
 - Who have been a WAPPA member for the immediate past 5 years and be located in a country region or remote school for the immediate past 5 years.
- Recommendations can be made by any financial WAPPA member to recommend a WAPPA Ordinary Member for consideration.
- Recommendations are to be supported by their Chapter Chair or a serving WAPPA Board Member.

Guidelines

- Recommendations are to be submitted using the **WAPPA Country Representative Award nomination form** addressing required criteria and;
 - May include any other **supporting documents** and/or names of other referees if applicable.
 - Be received by mhill@wappa.net.au by **4 pm on Friday 25th September 2020**.
- The WAPPA Board will carefully consider recommendations and will review evidence of the suitability of the member against the criteria for the WAPPA Country Representative Award.
- The final decision to award a WAPPA Country Representative Award will rest with the WAPPA Board.
- The WAPPA Board will not be required to give feedback on their decision.
