AGPPA Key Federal Election Priorities

AGPPA calls upon the Federal Government to:

- Have regular consultation with AGPPA in an honest, open, willing and timely manner.
AGPPA represents over 5,300 Primary School leaders and over 3.3 million voters from Government Schools across all States and Territories.
- Identify and resource the support that enhances school leader wellbeing.
“The most significant challenge for all these leaders is twofold: a) the increasing burden of workload; and b) the exponential increase in threats of, and actual violence experienced in the workplace.”ⁱ
- Increase funding for every primary student, so that the SRS for every Australian student is the same.
The SRS funding amounts in 2021 are \$12,099 for primary students and \$15,204 for secondary students.
- Ensure that all students in Australian government primary schools receive a minimum of 100% of the SRS.
*Catholic and Independent Schools receive 100% of the SRS (80% Federal and 20% State Government)
Government Schools receive up to 95% of the SRS (20% Federal and up to 75% State Government)*
- Ensure that state and territory education departments utilise the NCCD data to deliver the full allocation of resourcing to schools for students with complex and additional needs.
- Work with states and territories to ensure that government primary schools are fit for purpose to deliver the contemporary Australian Curriculum in full.
